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Greetings to all the DIET Principals. I wish to inform that as a part of implementing PEMANDU lab initiatives, 3Rs assessment test is planned to conduct on 18.10.2016 (tentative date) to all the students studying from II to V class both in Govt. and Pvt. Schools in A.P.

The initiative is aimed to become top ranking state in NAS (National Achievement Survey) by 2022. The key objective of the assessment test is to identify the children who need remediation and to provide a subsequent intensive remediation programme.

It is decided to utilize the D.El.Ed students' services as Field investigators (F.Is) for the conduct of the test said above. The details of number of D.El.Ed students required to your respective districts are furnished in the Annexure - I. Instructions to the F.Is, and all field functionaries regarding the conduct of test are also attached to this letter.

Hence the Principals of DIETs concerned are hereby requested to kindly convene a meeting with DEO, DPO SSA and the Principals of all Pvt. D.Ed and B.Ed colleges to discuss on the modalities of conduct of test in your districts.

U - DISE data shall be made utilized to identify the number of schools and the number of F.Is required at 2 per school. If the D.El.Ed students are not sufficient, you are requested to take measures to engage B.Ed students also.

Thus the Principals are requested to do necessary exercise on the tasks mentioned above well in advance and allot the F.Is to the respective mandals taking the proximity of their colleges into consideration.
